

### **THE GOSPEL OF JOHN, THE GOSPEL OF BELIEF**

### **PAUL: A BIOGRAPHY**

#### **Man for all moments and his radical messianic eschatology.**

Paul, the most quoted teacher of the early church, after his road to Damascus experience. The place where he saw the light and received his commission from the Lord himself is also one of the most misunderstood apostles. We know him namely for his writings to congregations and individuals, but little is known about his life before the Damascus road experience and afterwards. Few have ventured to understand what made him "tick" and what the real nature of his message was. If you come to this class keep an open mind to receive and understand what the Scriptures say or imply about Paul and what Paul says about himself. This will be more of a spiritual/psychological biography. (As someone has said, biography involves thinking into the minds of people who did not think the way we do) while at the same time not forgetting his everyday life. Some call this genre of biographical Pauline theology, Paulology. Come let us reason together. Isaiah 1:18a
