INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR FCC

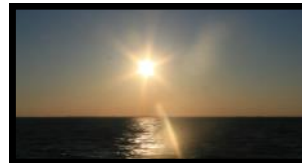
If there is a weather emergency declared by the State of Delaware (Level 1, 2 or 3), all services and activities will be cancelled during the emergency.

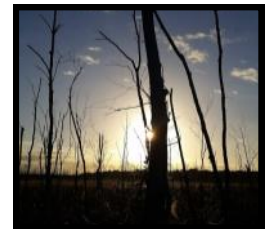
Animals that Defy Evolution
