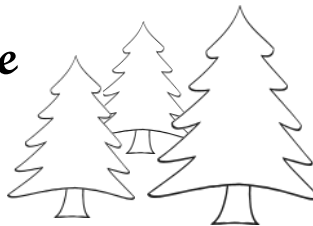

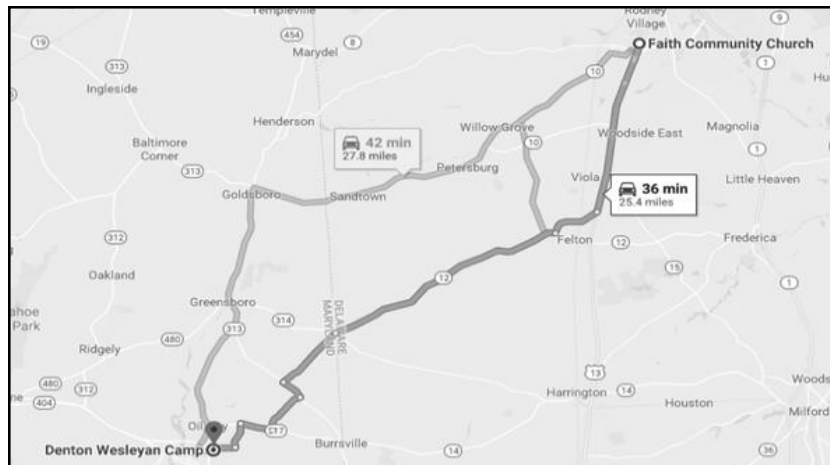

**Romans 2:15** *They show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts sometimes accusing them and at other times even defending them.*

Did you use to get a kick out cartoons where the main character was torn between a little devil whispering in one ear and an angel whispering in the other? Still today, whenever the subject of conscience comes up, many of us picture this image of the competing voices.
