Dear Church Family,

Yesterday morning the elders and a deacon met to pray for God's protection over our congregation during this trying time and to ask for His guidance and wisdom going forward. Here is a brief summary of what was discussed and decided.

- 1) Sunday Morning Services and all church activities will be cancelled up to and including Saturday, March 28th. As we monitor the coronavirus situation and developments in our area, we will prayerfully consider future decisions. We will keep you informed weekly.
- 2) The church secretaries and pastors will be in the church office during regular office hours-that has not changed.
- 3) Pastors are also still available to counsel.
- 4) Hospitals are limiting visitors so if you plan on visiting someone in the hospital, we recommend you call the hospital first for permission.

- 6) You may continue to worship the Lord through giving by mail or electronically with no fee for you or the church, using the "bill pay" feature through your online banking to Faith Community Church, PO Box 1, Camden, DE 19934.
- 7) We know this has been a challenging time for everyone, especially those in our FCC body that are at a higher risk for getting sick. If you are beginning to run out of something important (like medication or basic needs) because you're unable to leave your home, please let us know. The deacons will find a safe way to deliver these items to you.
- 8) If the current situation has caused financial difficulty for you, as always you may contact the church office for an Application for Assistance.
