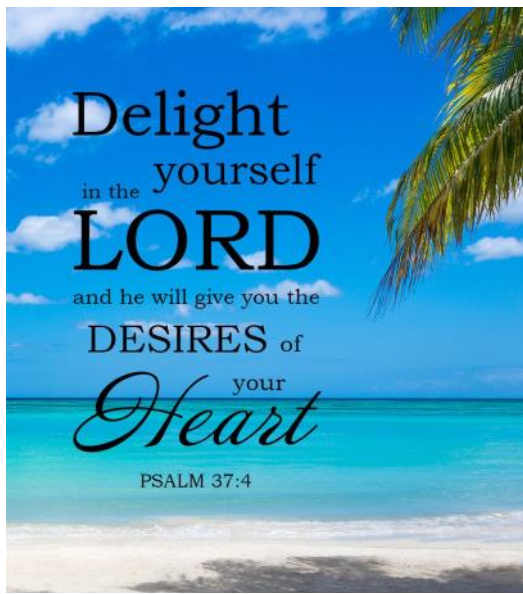

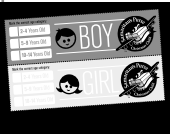


# HOW TO PACK YOUR SHOEBOX GIFT

## 1 SHOEBOX



Get a standard size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. Need shoeboxes? Great preprinted boxes are available on our website.

## 4 PRAY

Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note and photo to delight the heart of the child.

## 2 "WOW" ITEM

Select a quality "wow" toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal to bless a child.

## 5 DONATE \$9 PER BOX
